The Contracting Authority will award points in this one on the basis of the statement made by the contractor in the Bid Form regarding the employment of a disabled person to carry out the contract.

- The offer that obtains the highest number of points based on the established criteria will be considered the most advantageous. The remaining offers will be ranked according to the decreasing number of points.
